Thorn-Clarke Wines is family owned, with estate vineyards nestled in four distinct areas of the Barossa. The whites are sourced from our Mt Crawford vineyard in the cool climate Eden Valley (to the south) and the reds from three other sites - Kabinenge (on Tanunda's valley floor), Milton Park (to the east of Angaston) and St Kitts (to the north). Our vineyard diversity and subsequent ability to interregionally blend, combined with our control from the vineyard to the glass, allows us to create wines of incomparable complexity and balance.
